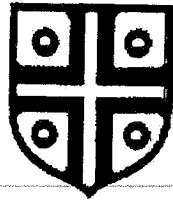

On or before November 1, 2017, and by November 1 every year thereafter, each higher education institution (the "HEI) shall provide an annual report concerning the immediately preceding calendar year to the Illinois Department of Human Rights and the Illinois Attorney General. The annual report shall include copies of the HEIs most recent comprehensive policy and written notification of a survivor's rights and options as well as aggregate data regarding trainings, prevention programs, incidents, reports, and complaint resolution outcomes.
